

Lubbock Power & Light Load Interconnection Inquiry Form:

How to use the form for Interconnections

Fill out the general information box

- Project name is the name of the project.
- Contact name is the primary contact in relation to the project.
- Phone number should connect to the person listed as the primary contact from above.
- Project address is the proposed project location. Please provide an address (or approximate address).
- Email is the primary contact's email address.
- Project size (MW) refers to the peak expected power draw size of the project.

Helpful information for the rest of the form

- 1. Please provide the interconnection voltage in volts or kV (Kilovolts).
- 2. Please provide an expected timeline for the project including initial ground-breaking and estimated production load date.
- 3. Please let us know how much growth is expected for the project within the first 5 years.
- 4. The nature of the project can be something like, but not necessarily limited, to the following:
 - a. Commercial Load.
 - b. Industrial Load.
 - c. Critical Infrastructure (As defined by <u>Texas Government Code Ch. 421 Sec. 421.001</u>).
- 5. Special project requirements are anything unique about the project requirements that are not outlined in the form but that should be noted for an interconnection study.
- Other information is any additional information that is helpful to know in characterizing the project. Examples include, but are not limited to the following:
 - a. Other addresses of interest.
 - b. Specific coordinates relating to the project.
 - c. Special forms or agreements that are already in place between interested parties.
 - d. Has Onsite Cogeneration.
